### About This Guide

This is the third in a six part series on 1 Peter entitled "Apart from the World for the Sake of the World." It will focus on our willingness to have a different attitude towards the world than those of the world do.

### Big Idea

This discussion reminds us that we are to practice submission, and be willing to suffer injustice, knowing that God will make it right in His time. Our entire worldview is different from those of the world and this view defines how we live out our mission in this world.
