Read Scripture: Joshua 3

God said to Joshua in Chapter1..." as I was with Moses, so will I be with you." Based on Joshua's confidence in what God told him, he gave the order to cross the Jordan, assuming the role Moses once had.

As Rahab observed in Joshua Chapter 2..."I know that the Lord has given you the land...". Based on her confidence in what God was doing with the Israelites, Rahab made a plan.

In Chapter 3, Joshua commanded the people...Sanctify yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do great wonders among you." He also commanded, "Come here, and hear the words of the Lord your God." And so it was that Joshua began to lay out the details of the plan to cross the Jordan river.
