As you look back on God's blessings in your life what hope does this give you to live an obedient faithful life following Christ today and in the future?

Read Scripture: Joshua 24:1-33

- In what ways today can you ensure that you are serving the LORD faithfully today (vs. 14)?
- What do you do to set boundaries to separate yourself from the gods of this world, i.e. busyness, the love of money, possessions, lust, sports, etc.?
- We were created with the freedom to make choices and perhaps the biggest choice to make is who you will follow in life. Joshua issues a challenge to choose who you will follow in Joshua 24:15. Read Romans 6:15-23 and discuss the implications of blessings and curses of this choice of who to follow in this life.
- Joshua makes this public proclamation, "as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD." What benefit would it be for you to make such a public proclamation, to your family, friends and neighbors?
